

No one really likes rules. But for a boat club to be a happy boat club some "courtesy" should be exercised.




put them back when your are finished using them



Be aware of others when carrying your boat. Give others a heads-up.

If a crew or sculler is carrying a boat, please move out of their way.



DON'T DOCK BLOCK move your shell out of the way to let others dock.





PUT A SOCK ON IT

pull one over the top of your oarlock to

keep from scratching other boats



WIPE DOWN THE BOAT clean any debris off the boat



TAKE THE PLASTIC take empty water bottles with you when you leave



FOR BOATS-NOT BUTTS the sling is made for a rowing shell only
