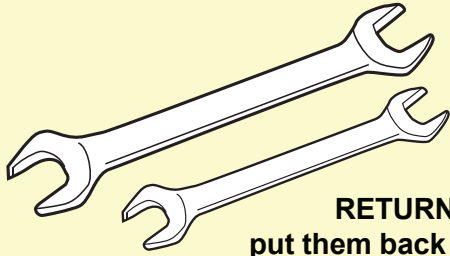

No one really likes rules. But for a boat club to be a happy boat club some “courtesy” should be exercised.

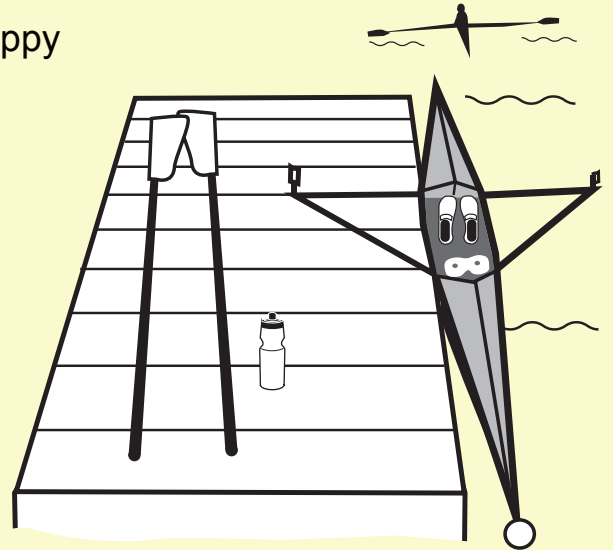


RETURN TOOLS
put them back when your are finished using them

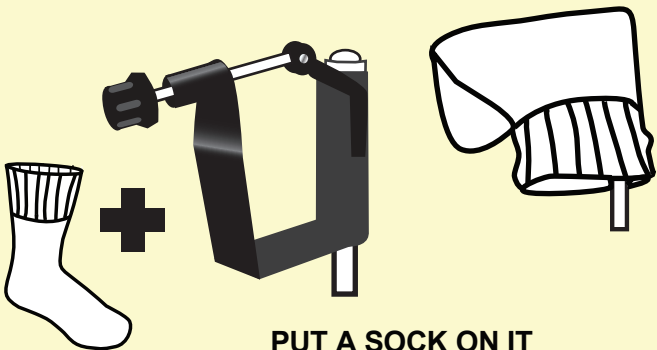


Be aware of others when carrying your boat. Give others a heads-up.

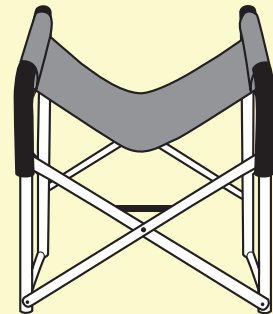
If a crew or sculler is carrying a boat, please move out of their way.



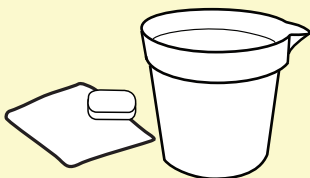
DON'T DOCK BLOCK
move your shell out of the way to let others dock.



PUT A SOCK ON IT
pull one over the top of your oarlock to keep from scratching other boats



FOR BOATS—NOT BUTTS
the sling is made for a rowing shell only



WIPE DOWN THE BOAT
clean any debris off the boat



TAKE THE PLASTIC
take empty water bottles with you when you leave
